Open Proclamation

In esteem and love before my aunt Olga Ritso Kistler living in the USA and the whole our Family Federation branch residing on the American continent, but also before the memory of my father, I feel a big debt of honour.

My father's sister Olga Ritso Kistler founded the well known Occupations Museum from her personal savings, this from esteem and sense of duty before the Estonian nation, who took the two orphans escaping from the revolution, 2 years old Olga together with her 6 years old brother, my father, to their families. Estonians took the high rank White Guardians' orphan children to their families with care and love affording to my father and aunt proper education as the mission to life.

Aunt Olga graduated from the Tartu University as an eye surgeon and left Estonia with the last ship to the historical fatherland as a ship doctor. After being seven years in the concentration camp, she chose her new living place the USA, where she started professional work as the eye surgeon. In the USA she met with her future husband Swiss origin Walter Paul Kistler. Like my father, also aunt Olga, regarded with great love and sense of duty towards the Estonian nation. Aunt was our frequent visitor together with her family and we visited aunt together with father in the USA, we also made a trip in Europe being guests of my aunt.

My father had always taught me to look in belief and hope towards the American nation. My father worked until 76 years as a scientist and professor at Tallinn University of Technology.

Since 11 September 2001 tragedy in New York until he left us on 18 January 2010 my father was sure that the Government of Estonia will establish a monument on the green area beside the Occupation Museum, established by his sister Olga, remembering this tragedy. For respect sign and attention thank of the Estonian nation and victims in America, which remarks the beginning of a new epoch to the whole world's peace loving nations.

Our state authorities unfortunately forgot to mark this important event for us with a monument. I believe that accidentally.

Some months ago in Italy, in city Stresa with ca 5000 inhabitants, the stylized twin-tower reminding monument affected sense dignifying. Then I felt shame before my father and American relatives that I have not managed to reach their expectations. I decided to establish on the behalf of our nation worldwide offertory at our Family Federation Arendia Elita von Wolsky FF to establish monument New York 11.09.2001 in Tallinn. I have the honour to be among the first donators. I believe that after the friendly reminder Estonian Government and Tallinn City also respond suitably. Aunt Olga can breath lighter and father gets grave peace. I believe that the whole Estonian nation understands that being the member state of the European Union it would be proper to mark the sorrow of our main economic and political partner with a little monument as it has been done by other bigger and smaller states. I would like to get ahead without accusing anybody from here this time.
