Presentation of Ordo Altaria Mariana

In 1201.a.D. Pont Max Innocentius III blessed to the Holy Virgin Mary the Baltic area, nowadays Estonia and Latvia, according to the Lord wish.

The Holy Terra Mariana was firstly governed by Riga Bishop Albert (von Buxhoeveden) through Conventus Terra Mariana (CTM). CTM is the eldest known Pan-European organisation at the place.

The re-establishment and leading of CTM was trusted according to the blessing of traditional Christian confessions' bishops and archbishops of local Churches' Council to Arendia Elita von Wolsky FF - Federatio Familorum (AEvW-FF).

For the 800th jubilee of the Holy Terra Marina highly blessed Ordo Altaria Mariana (OAM) was founded by Arendia Elita von Wolsky FF.

Bearing the bishops legitimacy, Roman Catholic Church Nuncio in the Baltic states, Archbishop Erwin Josef Ender, later Archbishop of Berlin, was ordained. Now residing in the service of the Holy See at the Everlasting Town.

Representative of the best Roman-Catholic Church traditions, not only in the Catholic environment, CTM has also the Ecumenical Prelate and Estonian Roman-Catholic Church Bishop, OAM Chevalier, Msgr. Philippe Jourdan, is the Vice on Chairman of the All-Estonian ecumenical Churches Council.

Since the jubilee year the OAM 30 ordens have been issued, from them Archbishops - 3 and Bishops - 2, Priests - 6, Knights and Honourable Knights – 17 and Clarissima Domina – 2 and advisors with the right to wear OAM miniature badge - 88.

The Elder of the Chapel of OAM is the Knights Cross Chevalier Count Ulrich Holstein-Holsteinborg, Estonian Honourable Consul in the Kingdom of Denmark. The Orders Chapel's the first advisor is Boris Pilar v. Pilchau.
